

Announcement Exemption of Visa on Arrival (VoA) Fee

By the Ministerial Regulation of the Ministry of Interior of the Kingdom of Thailand dated 11 January B.E. 2562 (2019), Thailand has implemented a temporary Visa on Arrival fee exemption scheme, starting from 14 January 2019 until 30 April 2019, which will apply for holders of passports/travel documents of Andorra, Bulgaria, Bhutan, China (including Taiwan but excluding Hong Kong and Macao), Cyprus, Ethiopia, Fiji, India, Kazakhstan, Latvia, Lithuania, Maldives, Malta, Mauritius, Papua New Guinea, Romania, San Marino, Saudi Arabia, Ukraine and Uzbekistan.

Nationals of the said countries/territories are entitled to be exempted from Visa on Arrival (VoA) fee of THB 2,000 when applying for Visa on Arrival (VoA) at designated immigration checkpoints in Thailand during the aforementioned period. The Visa on Arrival (VoA) allows travelers to stay in the Kingdom of Thailand for tourism purposes for a period of up to 15 days.
