



Announcement Exemption of Visa on Arrival (VoA) Fee

By the Ministerial Regulation of the Ministry of Interior of the Kingdom of Thailand dated 29 October B.E. 2562 (2019), Thailand has implemented a temporary Visa on Arrival (VoA) fee exemption scheme, starting from 1 November 2019 until 30 April 2020, which will apply for holders of passports/travel documents of Bulgaria, Bhutan, China, Cyprus, Ethiopia, Fiji, Georgia, India, Kazakhstan, Malta, Mexico, Nauru, Papua New Guinea, Romania, Russia, Saudi Arabia, Taiwan, Uzbekistan, Vanuatu.

Nationals of the said countries/territories are entitled to be exempted from Visa on Arrival (VoA) fee of THB 2,000 when applying for Visa on Arrival (VoA) at designated immigration checkpoints in Thailand during the aforementioned period. The Visa on Arrival (VoA) allows travelers to stay in the Kingdom of Thailand for tourism purposes for a period of up to 15 days.
