



Announcement
Suspension of Visa on Arrival (VoA) scheme
and
30-day Visa Exemption Scheme

By the Ministerial Regulation of the Ministry of Interior of the Kingdom of Thailand dated 12 March B.E. 2563 (2020), **starting from 13 March 2020 until 30 September 2020,**

1. Thailand will suspend the Visa on Arrival (VoA) scheme which will apply to holders of passports/travel documents from **Bulgaria, Bhutan, China (including Taiwan), Cyprus, Ethiopia, Fiji, Georgia, India, Kazakhstan, Malta, Mexico, Nauru, Papua New Guinea, Romania, Russia, Saudi Arabia, Uzbekistan, and Vanuatu.**

2. Thailand will suspend the 30-days Visa Exemption scheme which will apply to holders of passports/travel documents from **Hong Kong, Italy, and the Republic of Korea.**

This is in response to the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Outbreak. The nationals of the afore-mentioned countries wishing to travel to Thailand can apply for an entry visa to Thailand at the Royal Thai Consulate-General (Level 8, 131 Macquarie Street, Sydney 2000) on working days, from 09.30-12.30 hrs.
