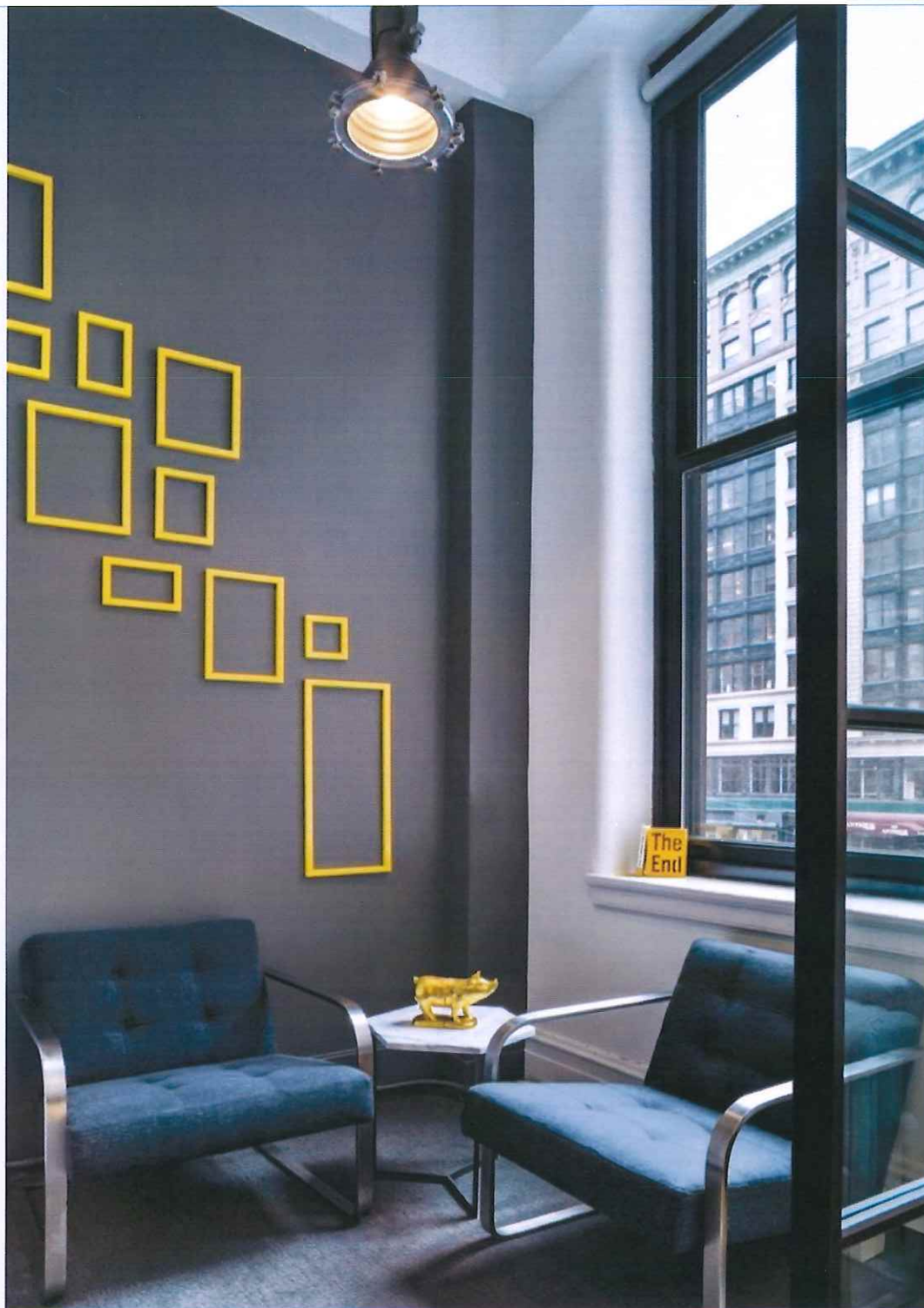

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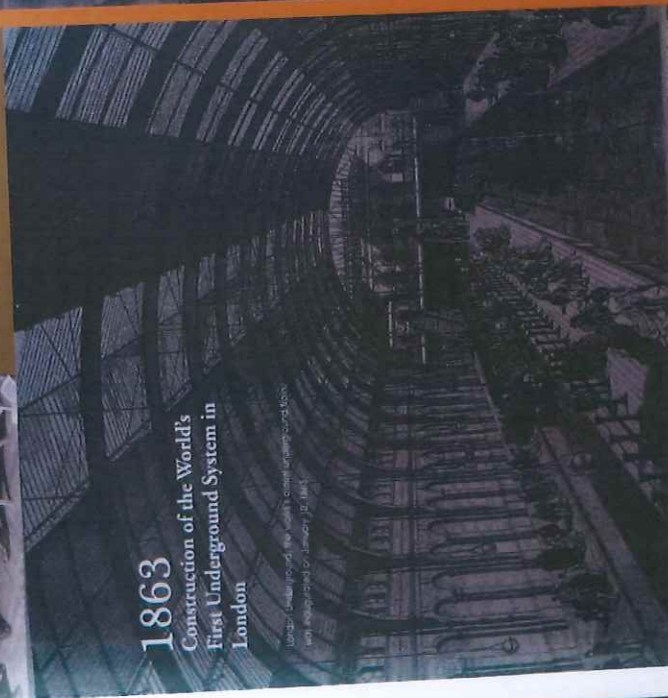


1863 Abolition of Slavery in America

U.S. President Abraham Lincoln signed the Emancipation Proclamation, freeing enslaved people across the country, which led to the four-year American Civil War. America became the first country where slaves were legally banned.

1863 Construction of the World's First Underground System in London

Underground, the world's first underground railway, was inaugurated on January 10, 1863.



1885 The World's First Internal Combustion Engine Automobile

A German inventor, Karl Benz, developed the world's first internal combustion engine automobile, which was used to transport people and goods.



1855 Sir John Bowring

A British diplomat, Sir John Bowring was sent as an envoy to the court of Queen Victoria to negotiate a treaty of commerce with the kingdom. He was the first British envoy to the kingdom, which led to the opening of the kingdom to the world.

1857 Siamese Envoy Sent to Strengthen Friendly Ties

King Rama IV sent an envoy and diplomatic corps to present his message to Queen Victoria of the United Kingdom. The visit was considered one of the most important in the history of Siam's relations with the world.

1863 Phra Borom Banphot

King Rama IV commanded that the renovation of Phra Borom Banphot, a famous temple in the Golden Mount, be resumed. The temple was a symbol of the kingdom's power and was used for religious and political purposes.



1861 Charoen Krung Road

Charoen Krung Road, the first road in the kingdom, was built in the reign of King Rama IV. The road was 1.5 kilometers long and connected the city to the river.

1868 The Occurrence of the Solar Eclipse

King Rama IV predicted the occurrence of a solar eclipse in the kingdom. The prediction was based on the kingdom's calendar and was used to demonstrate the king's power.

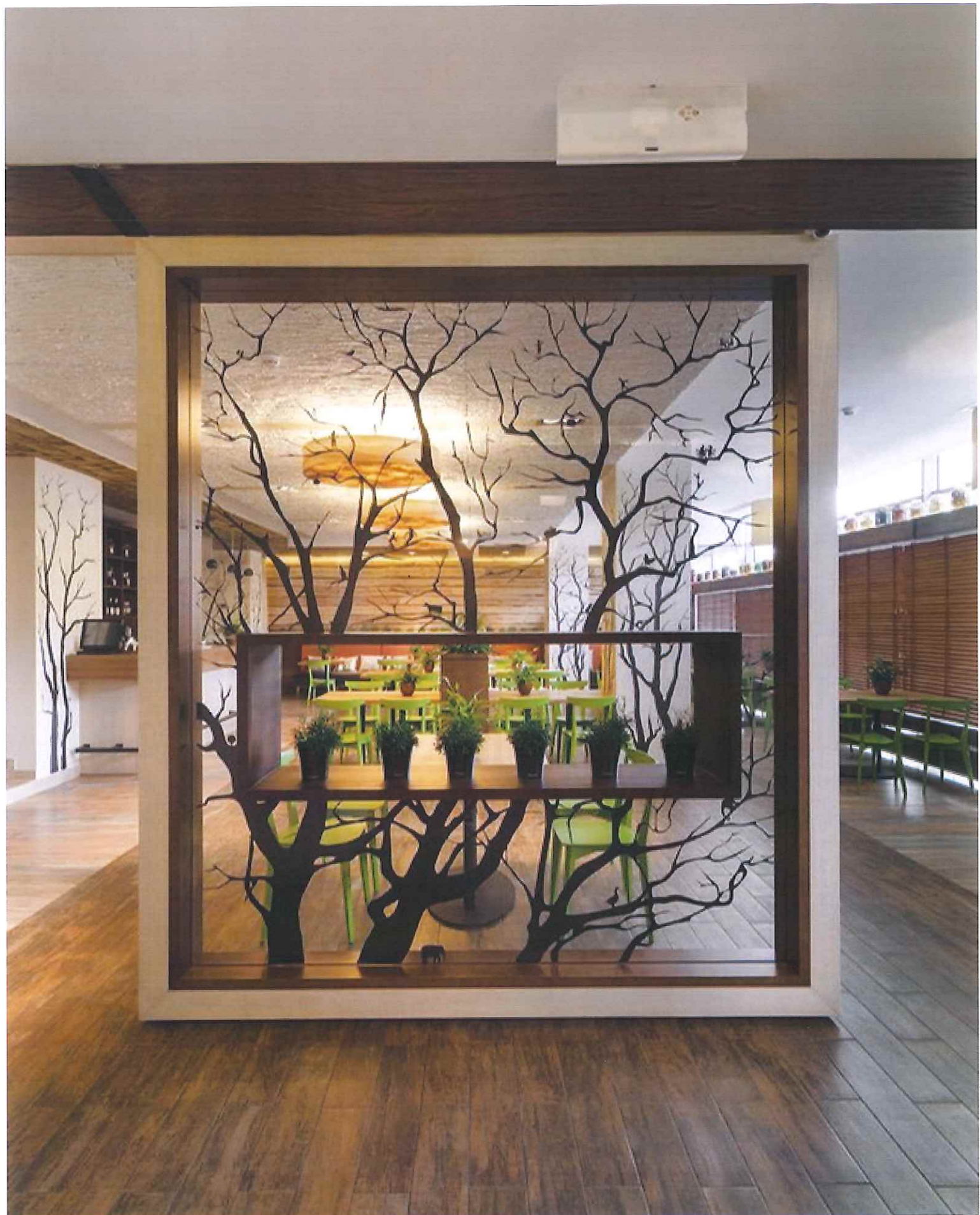
1884 Launch of Electricity Supply in Siam

Electricity was first introduced in the kingdom in 1884. The first power station was built in the city and was used to power the city's buildings.
