Order of the Prime Minister

No. 10/2563

Re : Appointment of Incident Commanders at Airports throughout the Kingdom

Pursuant to the Declaration of an Emergency Situation in all areas of the Kingdom of Thailand issued on 25 March B.E. 2563 (2020);

In order to remedy the problem of the outbreak of the communicable disease Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) at airports throughout the Kingdom in a more efficient and unified manner, by virtue of Section 7 paragraph two of the Emergency Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situations B.E. 2548 (2005), the Prime Minister hereby orders the Royal Thai Armed Forces Headquarters to appoint Incident Commanders at the Suvarnabhumi and Don Mueang International Airports, and hereby appoints Provincial Governors/Directors of the internal security of the responsible provinces as Incident Commanders for the international and provincial airports in their respective provinces, in order to command and supervise the functioning of the Emergency Operation Centre (EOC) at those airports, including to carry out other tasks assigned by the Prime Minister or the Council of Ministers.

This Order shall come into effect immediately.
