Purposes:

- To engage in business related activities in Thailand
- To visit Thailand as an investor in one of these categories:
- (1) has full ownership of a condominium in Thailand which worth at least THB 3 million.
- (2) has cash in a Thai bank for at least THB 3 million.
- (3) hold Thai government bond which worth at least THB 3 million.

Required Documents:

- 1. Original Passport with at least 6-month validity and 2 blank visa pages.
- 2. Three (3) copies of complete visa application form with three (3) passport size photos.
- 3. A copy of passport (ID page) and Malaysian pass with multiple entries which minimum validity 3 months.
 - For e-pass, a photocopy must be certified by Ministry of Foreign Affairs (Wisma Putra) before submit to the embassy.
- 4. Employment letter mentioning the applicant's name, position, purpose and dates of visit to Thailand
 - For self-employed, business license/registration under the applicant's name must be submitted.

5. Documents from counterpart in Thailand

- 5.1 A cover letter address to the Royal Thai Embassy mentioning the applicant's name, position, visa type, purpose, and duration of stay.
- 5.2 A copy of company's registration, business license with registered capital of at least THB 2 million.
- 5.3 A copy of company's list of shareholders.
- 5.4 A copy of company's latest balance sheet, statement of Income Tax and Business Tax (Por Ngor Dor 50 and Por Por 30)
- 5.5 A copy of the company's value-added tax (VAT) registration (Por Por 20)

OR proof that you

- (1) have full ownership of a condominium in Thailand which worth at least THB 3 million
- (2) has cash in Thai bank for at least THB 3 million
- (3) hold Thai government bond which worth at least THB 3 million.
- 6. Confirmation of transport tickets to enter and depart from Thailand.
- 7. Proof of accommodation for the whole period of stay in Thailand.
- 8. The applicant's original bank statement or bank book showing the account's name and number, balance and history of transaction last 3 months.
- 9. The tentative schedule for one year of travelling to Thailand (if need for multiple-entry).
- 10. For Nigerian citizens must attach the original Clearance Certificate issued by Nigeria's National Drug Law Enforcement Agency (NDLEA) or a certificate of Good Conduct issued by Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Malaysia.

Visa Fee: RM 320.- For single entry visa and RM 800.- For multiple entry visa.

Fee is exempted for national of Malaysia, Singapore, Republic of Korea and Tunisia

In submitting the application, I understand that:

- Additional documents may be required as deemed necessary by the Royal Thai Embassy.
- The Royal Thai Embassy reserves the right to reject any visa application if the reasons given are not fully supported and the visa fee is non-refundable.
