NON-IMMIGRANT VISA (B) and (IB) FOR EMPLOYMENT PURPOSE

Purpose of visit: - To be employed in Thailand

Required Documents:

- 1. Original Passport with at least 6-month validity and 2 blank visa pages.
- 2. Three (3) copies of complete visa application form with three (3) passport size photos.
- 3. A copy of passport (ID page) and Malaysian pass with multiple entries which minimum validity of 3 months.

For e-pass, a photocopy must be certified by Ministry of Foreign Affairs (Wisma Putra) before submit to the embassy.

4. Any of the followings:

- 4.1 A copy of work permit in Thailand (if any)
- 4.2 Letter of approval from the Ministry of Labour of Thailand or Form WP.32 (บด.32)
- 4.3 Letter from the Board of Investment of Thailand (BOI)

5. Documents from counterpart in Thailand

- 5.1 A cover letter address to the Royal Thai Embassy mentioning the applicant's name, position, salary, employment period and visa type.
- 5.2 A copy of company's registration, business license with registered capital of at least THB 2 million.
- 5.3 A copy of company's list of shareholders.
- 5.4 A copy of company's latest balance sheet, statement of Income Tax and Business Tax (Por Ngor Dor 50 and Por Por 30)
- 5.5 A copy of the company's value-added tax (VAT) registration (Por Por 20)
- 6. Employment letter mentioning the applicant's name, position, purpose and dates of visit to Thailand.
 - For self-employed, business license/registration under the applicant's name must be submitted.
- 7. The applicant's original bank statement or bank book showing the account's name and number, balance and history of transaction last 3 months.
- 8. For Nigerian citizens must attach the original Clearance Certificate issued by Nigeria's National Drug Law Enforcement Agency (NDLEA) or a certificate of Good Conduct issued by Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Malaysia.

Visa Fee: RM 320 for single entry visa.

Fee is exempted for national of Malaysia, Singapore, Republic of Korea and Tunisia

Non-immigrant visa (B) is valid for single entry into Thailand and must be used within 90 days from the issuance date.

Upon arrival, the holder of Non-immigrant visa (B) will be granted initial permit to stay in Thailand up to 90 days. Within 90 days after entry into Thailand, the holders of Non-immigrant visa (B) must obtain a work permit from the Department of Employment.

With the work permit, the holder of Non-immigrant vis a (B) can apply for an extension of stay to 1-year multiple entries from the immigration Bureau.

In submitting the application, I understand that:

- Additional documents may be required as deemed necessary by the Royal Thai Embassy.
- The Royal Thai Embassy reserves the right to reject any visa application if the reasons given are not fully supported and the visa fee is non-refundable.
