9. Approval letter from the Tourism Authority of Thailand. (if applicable)
10. Cover letter from the production coordinator in Thailand.
11. For Nigerian citizens, original Clearance Certificate issued by Nigeria's National Drug Law
Enforcement Agency (NDLEA) or the Letter of Good Conduct issued by Ministry of Foreign
Affairs of Malaysia.

Visa Fee: RM 320.- for single entry visa

Fee is exempted for national of Malaysia, Singapore, Republic of Korea and Tunisia.

In submitting the application, I understand that:

- Additional documents may be required as deemed necessary by the Royal Thai Embassy.
- The Royal Thai Embassy reserves the right to reject any visa application if the reasons given are not fully supported and the visa fee is non-refundable.
