### **NON-IMMIGRANT VISA (O) FOR RETIREMENT**

**Purpose of visit:** To stay in Thailand for a long period.

**Qualifications to apply:**

- Must be at least 50 years old.
- Not being prohibited from entering Thailand under the immigration Act B.E. 2522 (1979).
- Having no criminal record against the security of Thailand and the applicant's country of origin.
- Not having prohibited diseases indicated in the Ministry of Health Regulation No. 14 B.E. 2535 (1992) e.g. Leprosy, Tuberculosis, Drug Addiction, Elephantiasis and Third-stage of Syphilis.

**Required Documents:**

|  | 1. Original Passport with at least 6-month validity and 2 blank visa pages.  |

|  | 5. Medical certificate issued within the last months showing no prohibitive diseases as indicated in the Ministerial Regulation No. 14 B.E. 2535 (1992) e.g. Leprosy, Tuberculosis, Drug Addiction, Elephantiasis and Third-stage of Syphilis. |
|  | 6. Proof of Health Insurance with a policy of inpatient benefit (IPD) of not less than 400,000 THB/year and outpatient benefit (OPD) of less than 40,000 THB/year.   |
|  | 7. A certificate of criminal record in the applicant's country of origin or current country of residence issued by the competent authority within the last 3 months.   |
|  | 8. The applicant's original bank statement with a minimum deposit equivalent to 800,000 THB or Income Certificate with a minimum monthly income equivalent to 65,000 THB.  |

**Visa Fee:** RM 320 for single entry visa.

Fee is exempted for national of Malaysia, Singapore, Republic of Korea and Tunisia

**Remark:** Non-immigrant O for retirement visa is valid for 90-day single-entry and must be extend to 1-year multiple entry at the immigration bureau.

**In submitting the application, I understand that:**

- Additional documents may be required as deemed necessary by the Royal Thai Embassy.
- The Royal Thai Embassy reserves the right to reject any visa application if the reasons given are not fully supported and the visa fee is non-refundable.
