TRANSIT VISA (TS)

<u>Purpose of visit</u>: To travel in transit for more than 12 hours through the Kingdom in order to proceed to the country of destination or to re-enter their own country.

Remarks: All requirement must be provided in English or Thai.

Required Documents:

- 1. Original Passport with at least 6-month validity and 2 blank visa pages.
- 2. Three (3) completed visa application forms with (3) passport size photos.
- A copy of passport (ID page) and Malaysian pass with multiple entries which minimum validity of 3 months.
 For e-pass, a photocopy must be certified by Ministry of Foreign Affairs (Wisma Putra)
- before submit to the embassy.4. A confirmation of transport tickets to enter and depart from Thailand.
- 5. The applicant's bank statement or bank book showing the account's name and number, balance and history of transactions for last 3 month (should have minimum ending balance 10,000 THB/person or 20,000 THB/family or equivalent)
- 6. Visa of a third country in a passport or travel document (if any)
- 7. A certificate of relationship e.g., birth/marriage certificate etc. (for travelling as family group)
- 8. For Nigerian citizens, original Clearance Certificate issued by Nigeria's National Drug Law Enforcement Agency (NDLEA) or the Letter of Good Conduct issued by Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Malaysia must be attached.

Visa Fee: RM 125.- (for single entry)

Fee is exempted for national of Malaysia, Singapore, Republic of Korea and Tunisia

In submitting the application, I understand that:

- Additional documents may be required as deemed necessary by the Royal Thai Embassy.
- The Royal Thai Embassy reserves the right to reject any visa application if the reasons given are not fully supported and the visa fee is non-refundable.
