## **NON-IMMIGRANT VISA (M) FOR MEDIA**

- Purpose of visit:**
- To cover the news
  - To shoot films/ documentaries/ commercials in Thailand

**Required document:**

1. Three (3) completed visa application form with three (3) passport-size photos.
2. Original Passport with at least 6-month validity and 2 blank visa pages.
3. Three (3) copies of passport. (ID page)
4. A copy of Malaysian Pass with multiple entries and minimum 3 months validity. For e-pass, a photocopy must be certified by Ministry of Foreign Affairs (Wisma Putra) before submit to the embassy.

**Additional documents required for media visiting Thailand to cover the news:**

5. Cover letter from the applicant's organization.
6. A copy of organization's registration in Thailand.
7. Personal profile of the applicant.
8. A Certificate of criminal record from the applicant's country of origin.
9. Approval letter from Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Thailand

**Additional documents for media visiting Thailand to shoot films/ documentaries/ commercials:**

10. Approval letter from the Tourism Authority of Thailand. (if any)
11. Cover letter from the production coordinator in Thailand.
12. For Nigerian citizens must attach the original Clearance Certificate issued by Nigeria's National Drug Law Enforcement Agency (NDLEA) or the certificate of Good Conduct issued by Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Malaysia.

**Visa Fee:** RM 320.- for single entry visa

Fee is exempted for national of Malaysia, Singapore, Republic of Korea and Tunisia.

**In submitting the application, I understand that:**

- Additional documents may be required as deemed necessary by the Royal Thai Embassy.
- The Royal Thai Embassy reserves the right to reject any visa application if the reasons given are not fully supported and the visa fee is non-refundable.
