

Non-Thai nationals who eligible to enter Thailand on Special Tourist Visa (STV) Checklist Form

Please tick in the circle

- Two application forms, completely filled and signed by the applicant (All information must be correct, accurate, and legible.)
- Checklist form, completely filled and signed by the applicant
- Appointment confirmation through email
- Original passport of the applicant, which must be **valid for at least 12 months** from the date of travel
- Applicants must hold **a passport of Sri Lanka or must have permanent residence in Sri Lanka**
- Two photocopies of a bio-data page of the applicant's passport in A4 size
- Two identical colour photographs, which must be:
 - of the size of 3.5 cm x 4.5 cm taken within the last 6 months taken in front of a plain white or off white background
 - taken in fullface view directly facing the camera without eye glasses
 - with a neutral facial expression, both eyes open, and clearly visible hairline and ears
 - unretouched with standard or high resolution
- Financial proof, which must be
 - 1) Original updated 6month bank statement(s) (certified by the issuing bank), which must have a final balance of at least **LKR 3,000,000 (THB 500,000) or equivalent value end of each month** (per one person) with contact details of the bank **or**
 - 2) Confirmation of applicant/immediate family member's **complete ownership a condominium in Thailand or**
 - 3) Evidence showing that an applicant is in **the process of buying or leasing a condominium in Thailand and that the applicant has already paid at least 2 instalments for the property.**
- **Medical certificate** from a licensed doctor; Applicants must have no forbidden diseases according to the Ministerial Regulation No. 14 (B.E. 2535) which include Leprosy, Tuberculosis, Elephantiasis, drug addiction and third stage of Syphilis. The certificate must not be valid more than 3 months
- **Certificate of criminal record clearance** from country of permanent residence. The certificate must be valid not less than 3 months.
- **Alternative State Quarantine (ASQ) or Alternative Hospital Quarantine (AHQ) reservation** (For the list of ASQ and AHQ, please visit <http://www.hsscovid.com>)
- Post-Quarantine accommodation
 - **In case of staying in a hotel**, please submit copies of booking confirmation for the whole period of stay in Thailand and payment receipt with name, address, contact details and tax ID number of the hotel
 - **In case of staying in a rental condominium house**, please submit booking confirmation for the whole period of stay in Thailand and payment receipt with name, address, contact details and tax ID number of the owner
 - **In case the applicant/immediate family member owns a condominium**, please submit confirmation of applicant/immediate family members complete property ownership
 - **In case the applicant is buying or leasing a condominium**, please submit copies of documents stating that applicant has already paid at least 2 instalments
- **Valid medical/health insurance certificate issued by a Thai insurance company** indicating that:
 - 1) **cover at least 90 days (from your arrival date)** or the whole period of stay in Thailand
 - 2) have medical coverage in Thailand for **outpatient of at least 40,000 Baht**
 - 3) have medical coverage in Thailand for **inpatient of at least 400,000 Baht**
 - 4) cover all medical expenditures **including COVID-19 with coverage of at least USD 100,000**(For more information, please visit <http://longstay.tgia.org>)

I declare that I am not inadmissible to enter Thailand in accordance with Thai laws and regulations and that all information and documents submitted are true and genuine. If not, I acknowledge the right of the Embassy to take legal action against me.

Please Note that:

1. The Embassy has the right to reject an incomplete or damaged application form; or an application with incomplete or unclear or illegible documents.
2. The Embassy has the right to request (an) additional document(s) other than the documents stated in this form.
3. The Embassy shall not issue visas to applicants who provide untrue information or fake documents, and shall blacklist those who do so.
4. Please be reminded that the STV visa is valid only for the purpose of tourism and applicants who misuse the visa will be blacklisted by the Thai authorities.
5. Keep up-to-date with the latest developments for your flight and destination before your trip.
6. All photocopies submitted to the Embassy must be in A4 size.
7. The Embassy has authority to issue visas to foreigners who wish to travel to Thailand. However, the authority to permit entry and stay in Thailand lies with the Immigration Officer.
