



ANNOUNCEMENT
on the Temporary Suspension of Visa Exemption and
Visa on Arrival (VoA) for Certain Countries and Territory

By virtue of the Order of the Minister of Interior of the Kingdom of Thailand No.1/2563 dated 12 March B.E. 2563 (2020), as a measure to prevent the spread of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) pandemic, **Thailand have temporarily suspended, from 13 March – 30 September 2020:**

1. VISA EXEMPTION offered unilaterally by the Royal Thai Government to nationals and/or holders of passports/travel documents of

- (1) Hong Kong SAR,
- (2) Italy,
- (3) Republic of Korea

2. VISA ON ARRIVAL (VoA) schemes for nationals and/or holders of passports/travel documents of

Nationals of the above-mentioned countries and territory who wish to apply for visa at the Royal Thai Embassy in Colombo may continue do so during the announced office hours, subject to current rules and regulations.
