

Announcement on Thai e-Visa Stickerless System

Effective from 27 September 2021, foreign nationals, with a residence in Canada and select Caribbean countries*, who wish to apply for a Thai visa at the Embassy must apply and submit his/her application through the new online e-Visa platform at http://thaievisa.go.th. Please note that it is no longer required for applicants to submit his/her passport and original supporting documents to the Embassy.

After the e-Visa application has been approved, a confirmation e-mail will be sent to applicants. It is kindly requested that applicants print a copy of the confirmation e-mail to present to airline and Thai immigration officials when traveling to Thailand. The timeline of the transition to the e-Visa Stickerless System is as follows:

Date/Time (Eastern Time)	Procedure
17 September 2021	Last day to receive e-Visa applications with visa sticker via Thai e-Visa system.
18-22 September 2021	Pending applications in the Thai e-Visa system will be considered once the stickerless visa is implemented on 27 September 2021.
23 September 2021	Last day to approve and issue e-Visa stickers.
23 September 2021 2021 07.00 hrs 26 September 2021 19.00 hrs. 27 September 2021	Thai e-Visa system is temporarily shut down for system upgrade. Full operation of the Thai e-Visa Stickerless System.
