Scholarships will cover students' tuition fees, visa, registration, monthly stipend (800 AZN, includes meals, accommodation and utility costs), medical insurance and international flight (once in a year) at the expense of the Azerbaijan Government.

The candidates must submit their documents to the Embassy of the Republic of Azerbaijan to Malaysia before **March 15, 2018**.

The selection process will cover two stages:

- Review of the relevant documents
- Interviews (online/skype)

The candidates will be informed about the results by early May.

The five-year program will see allocation of a total of 100 scholarships (20 scholarships per year).

Scholarship will cover students' tuition fees, visa, registration, accommodation, daily meal expenses, transportation (excluding taxi), utility bills, any required course resources, insurance and a return ticket once a year at the expense of the Azerbaijani government.
