

**Checklist of Documents  
for  
Non-Thai nationals who want to visit Thailand for business**

1. For Visa Application (Non-Imm B)

- Application form filled and signed by the applicants
- Original passport and its copy
- Copy of Bahrain Residence Permit
- Copy of Bahrain CPR
- Copy of plane ticket
- Copy of reservation of hotel or other types of accommodation
- Two passport size photos
- Bank statement with the minimum balance of 6,250 BD for each of the last 6 months
- Invitation letter from a Thai company with the minimum registered capital of 2,000,000 baht or proof of ownership of a condominium unit or Thai government bond or deposit in a bank in Thailand which worths more than 3,000,000 baht.

Visa fees: BHD 30.000 (Single Entry)

2. For Certificate of Entry (COE) Application

- Completed Declaration Form
- Health Insurance Policy with the coverage of medical treatment in Thailand, including COVID-19 treatment, in the minimum amount of 100,000 USD or equivalent
- Proof of Alternative State Quarantine (ASQ) hotel booking for 14 days (if your travel date cannot be confirmed, please make a flexible booking with the hotel)

*\*\*\* Consul may ask for more documents as it is deemed necessary\*\*\*\*\**

**Reminder: All non-Thai nationals travelling to Thailand must have the following documents (for boarding the plane):**

- Certificate of Entry (applied at the Embassy)
- A valid visa or re-entry permit
- Negative COVID-19 RT-PCR test result, undertaken no longer than 72 hours before the flight departure (other kinds of test are not accepted)
- Fit to Fly health certificate issued no longer than 72 hrs before the flight departure
- Confirmation of Alternative State Quarantine (ASQ) booking for 14 days
