

**Checklist of Documents
For
Non-Thai nationals who are in need of medical treatment in Thailand, and their
attendants(maximum of 3), excluding COVID-19 treatment**

1. For Visa Application (Non-Imm O)

- Application form filled and signed by the applicants
- Original passport and its copy
- Copy of Bahrain Residence Permit
- Copy of Bahrain CPR
- Medical certificates showing the state of health or condition the patient
- Proof that the patient can cover the cost of medical treatment and other expenses while staying in Thailand (e.g. bank statement or letter of guarantee from government office/GOSI)
- Copy of plane ticket
- Two passport size photos

Visa fees: BHD 30.000 (Single Entry) BHD 65.000 (Multiple Entries)

2. For Certificate of Entry (COE) Application

- Completed declaration form
- Copy of passport
- Health Insurance Policy with the coverage of medical treatment in Thailand, including COVID-19 treatment, in the minimum amount of 100,000 USD or equivalent
- Confirmation Letter from the Ministry of Public Health of Thailand for the admission of the patient and arrangement of an alternative hospital quarantine (AHQ) for the period of at least 14 days (For the patient)*
- Affidavit of Support (For the attendant)*

Note

- The patient can be accompanied by 3 people at maximum and they need to be quarantined at the same hospital as the patient. The period of their stay in Thailand needs to be at least 14 days.
- To obtain the Confirmation Letter and Affidavit of Support, the patient must contact the hospitals that are assigned as AHQ directly to provide necessary information. The hospital will then seek approval from the Ministry of Public Health of Thailand of the patient's behalf and provide the patient with the said documents.

*** *Consul may ask for more documents as it is deemed necessary****

Reminder: All non-Thai nationals travelling to Thailand must have the following documents (for boarding the plane):

- Certificate of Entry
- A valid visa or re-entry permit
- Negative COVID-19 RT-PCR test result, undertaken no longer than 72 hours before the flight departure (other kinds of test are not accepted)
- Fit to Fly health certificate issued no longer than 72 hrs before the flight departure
- Confirmation of AHQ booking for 14 days
