

**Checklist of Documents  
for  
Non-Thai nationals who are students of educational institutions approved by Thai  
authorities, including the parents or guardians of the students.**

1. Students of educational institutions approved by Thai authorities are:

- Public or private schools
- Public or private universities
- International schools or International Universities

This does not include include students of non-formal educational institutions within the meaning of Law on Private School B.E.2550 or other institutions alike.

2. For Visa Application (Non-Imm ED for students and Non-Imm O for parents or guardians)

- Application form filled and signed by the applicants
- Original passport and its copy
- Copy of Bahrain Residence Permit
- Copy of Bahrain CPR
- Copy of the marriage certificate (for spouse) and/or copy of the birth certificate (for parent or child)
- Copy of plane ticket
- Two passport size photos
- Letter confirming the student status or admission of the student
- An attestation from the Ministry of Education or other relevant authority that regulates the concerned institution (except for International schools or Higher educational institutions)
- Good Conduct Certificate/Criminal Record Clearance (for student over the age of 18 only)
- Bank statement of at least 3 months and a letter of guarantee from parent(s)
- Official documents confirming relationship of parents or guardians (in case of their request of entry)

Visa fees: BHD 30.000 (Single Entry) BHD 65.000 (Multiple Entries)

3. For Certificate of Entry (COE) Application

- Completed Declaration Form
- Health Insurance Policy with the coverage of medical treatment in Thailand, including COVID-19 treatment, in the minimum amount of 100,000 USD or equivalent
- Proof of Alternative State Quarantine (ASQ) hotel or Organizational Quarantine (OQ) booking for 14 days (if your travel date cannot be confirmed, please make a flexible booking with the hotel)

*\*\*\* Consul may ask for more documents as it is deemed necessary\*\*\**

**Reminder: All non-Thai nationals travelling to Thailand must have the following documents (for boarding the plane):**

- Certificate of Entry (applied at the Embassy)
- A valid visa or re-entry permit
- Negative COVID-19 RT-PCR test result, undertaken no longer than 72 hours before the flight departure (other kinds of test are not accepted)
- Fit to Fly health certificate issued no longer than 72 hrs before the flight departure
- Confirmation of Alternative State Quarantine (ASQ) or Organizational Quarantine (OQ) booking for 14 days
