

**Required Documents
for Long Stay Visas (OA, OX)**

Non-Immigrant O-A - period of each stay up to 1 year

O-X - period of each stay up to 5 years

- A. Long – Stay (O-A).....2
- B. Long-stay (5 years) for foreigners age over 50 and family (O-X).....3

A. Long – Stay (O-A)

1. Biodata page of Passport or Travel Document, which is valid for at least 6 months (.jpg, .jpeg only)
2. Photograph taken within the last six months (.jpg, .jpeg only)
3. Applicant must be at least 50 years of age (on the day of submitting application)
4. Proof of the permanent residence in the country where the application is submitted
5. Financial evidence showing monthly income of no less than 65,000 THB or having the current balance of 800,000 THB, e.g. bank statements, proof of earnings
6. A medical certificate issued from the country where the application is submitted, showing no prohibitive diseases (Leprosy, Tuberculosis, Drug Addiction, Elephantiasis, third phase of Syphilis) as indicated in the Ministerial Regulation No.14 (B.E. 2535) (certificate shall be valid for not more than three months)
7. Foreign Insurance Certificate as stipulated by the Office of Insurance Commission and Health Insurance of Thailand, which must be completed, signed and stamped by the insurance company. The form can be downloaded from <https://longstay.tgia.org>
8. Health Insurance issued by a Thai or foreign insurer for general illnesses, including COVID-19, with the insured sum of no less than 100,000 USD or 3,000,000 THB
9. Certificate of criminal record clearance from the country of nationality or the country where the application is submitted
10. Additional supporting documents:
 - Certificate of entry and departure (at least 1-year record)

All submitted documents must be in English or Thai

B. Long-stay (5 years) for foreigners age over 50 and family (O-X)

1. Biodata page of Passport or Travel Document, which is valid for at least 6 months (.jpg, .jpeg only)
2. Photograph taken within the last six months (.jpg, .jpeg only)
3. Proof of the permanent residence in the country where the application is submitted
4. Financial evidence with fixed deposit of no less than 3,000,000 THB or no less than 1,800,000 THB together with monthly income of no less than 1,200,000 THB per year in Thai bank located in Thailand
5. A medical certificate issued from the country where the application is submitted, showing no prohibitive diseases (Leprosy, Tuberculosis, Drug Addiction, Elephantiasis, third phase of Syphilis) as indicated in the Ministerial Regulation No.14 (B.E. 2535) (certificate shall be valid for not more than three months)
6. Foreign Insurance Certificate as stipulated by the Office of Insurance Commission and Health Insurance of Thailand, which must be completed, signed and stamped by the insurance company. The form can be downloaded from <https://longstay.tgia.org>
7. Health Insurance issued by an insurer in Thailand with outpatient benefit of no less than 40,000 THB and inpatient benefit of no less than 400,000 THB
8. Certificate of criminal record clearance from the country of nationality (In case that the applicants have permanent residence in other country, the aforementioned document from both country of nationality and country of permanent residence is required.)
9. Biography
10. Additional supporting documents:
 - Certificate of entry and departure (at least 1-year record)
