 - Unregistered media representatives <u>will not</u> be permitted to enter the meetings premises and the Media Center.
- 2. Upon completion of registration, foreign media representatives residing outside Thailand are <u>required to apply for appropriate visas</u> before entering the country. Please present proof of complete registration along with other required documents at the Royal Thai Embassies and Royal Thai Consulates-General for visa application.
