Recruitment of a Full-Time Employee for the Position of Driver

1. Qualifications

- Male, Hong Kong resident and/or legally holding a Hong Kong work permit.
- Holding a Hong Kong driving license
- At least 25 years of age
- Completed lower secondary education or equivalent or higher
- Capable of communicating in Thai, or English or Cantonese
- At least 3 years of driving experience
- Well known with Hong Kong routes
