- **Official name** – The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.
- **Four united countries** – England, Scotland, Northern Ireland and Wales.
- **Capital cities** – London, Edinburgh, Belfast and Cardiff.
- **Main language spoken** in the UK is English – in addition to Scots, Gaelic and Welsh.
- **UK's currency** – the pound (£ or £GBP)



- **Autumn** (September to November).
- **Winter** (December to February) average temperature 2–7°C but at the coldest can be just below 0°C.
- **Spring** (March to May).
- **Summer** (June to August) average temperature 9–18°C but at the hottest can be up to 30°C.

# NEW GRADUATE ROUTE LAUNCHES 1 JULY 2021



The UK's new Graduate Route allows you to apply to stay in the UK for up to two years after you finish your undergraduate or master's degree, to work or look for work. Students who complete their PhD will be able to stay for three years.

- Open to all international students who complete their degree from 1 July 2021 onwards.
- Successful applicants will be able to stay and work, or look for work, in the UK for a maximum period of two years.\* Students who complete their PhD will be able to stay for three years.
- Ability to switch to a skilled work visa once you have found a suitable job.
- You must complete a degree at undergraduate level (or above) at a UK higher education provider with a track record of compliance.

\*The route is non-extendable/does not count towards settlement.

# THE NHS

**The UK's National Health Service (NHS) provides subsidised treatment and healthcare to international students.**

As part of your visa application, you will pay an Immigration Health Surcharge.

This will allow you to use the NHS for:

- consulting a GP on any physical or mental health issue
- accident and emergency services (excluding follow-up treatments and in-patient admissions)
- diagnosis of sexually transmitted disease
- getting a Covid-19 vaccination.
