



**Announcement of Mae Fah Luang University  
Partial Scholarships for Master's and Doctoral Degrees for International Students  
Academic Year 2026**

Mae Fah Luang University (MFU) is pleased to announce the opening of applications for partial scholarships available to international students for the Academic Year 2026. The scholarship aims to support academically outstanding international students and to promote academic excellence in their chosen fields of study at Mae Fah Luang University.

### **1. Scholarship Benefits**

The scholarship covers tuition fees only for the approved programme of study.

### **2. Available Programmes**

These scholarships are available to international students whose proposed fields of study and research topics align with the University's strategic priorities, including:

#### **Master's Degree Programmes**

- **Business Administration**  
**Thesis areas:** Strategic Management; Entrepreneurial Management
- **International Logistics and Supply Chain Management**  
**Thesis areas:** International Trade for Logistics; Cross Border Trade; Urban and Transport Management
- **Materials Innovation for Sustainability**  
**Thesis area:** Sustainable Material Engineering

#### **Doctoral Degree Programmes**

- **Business Administration**  
**Thesis areas:** Tourism Management; Advanced Urban and Transport Management
- **International Logistics and Supply Chain Management**  
**Thesis areas:** International Trade for Logistics; Cross-Border Trade
- **Materials Innovation for Sustainability**  
**Thesis area:** Sustainable Material Engineering

### **3. Qualifications and Eligibility**

To be eligible for the scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

#### **3.1 Academic Qualifications**

##### **Master's Degree programmes**

Applicants must hold a bachelor's degree or an equivalent qualification from an accredited university with a minimum GPA of 3.00. The degree certificate must be officially certified by the relevant authority of the applicant's country of origin .

##### **Doctoral Degree programmes**

Applicants must hold a master's degree or an equivalent qualification from an accredited university with a minimum GPA of 3.5. The degree certificate must be officially certified by the relevant authority of the applicant's country of origin .

### 3.2 English Language Proficiency

Applicants must submit evidence of English language proficiency by presenting one of the following test scores. The test result must be valid for no more than two years at the time of application.

MFU-TEP (CEFR B2)	60
TOEIC (Listening and Reading)	785

### 4. Selection Process

Scholarships will be awarded based on the applicant's academic performance and their demonstrated potential to contribute to the development of global citizenship within the University community. This potential will be assessed through the proposed plans and activities outlined in the Statement of Purpose submitted as part of the scholarship application.

### 5. Scholarship Conditions

The awardees are required to adhere to the following conditions throughout their studies:

- a) Maintain a semester GPA of 3.25 or higher.
- b) Contribute a minimum of 30 hours per semester to job assistance or service activities at Mae Fah Luang University.
- c) Implement the approved activity or initiative proposed in the Statement of Purpose during the first year of study.
- d) Pursue their studies with diligence and maintain good conduct.
- e) Comply with all applicable university rules and regulations.
- f) Participate regularly in university extracurricular activities.
- g) Remain informed of official university announcements and communications.
- h) Submit academic results to the Global Relations Division within two (2) weeks after the official announcement of grades each semester.
- i) Obtain prior approval from the Scholarship Committee before applying for any additional scholarships

### 6. Termination of Scholarship

The University reserves the right to terminate the scholarship in the event that a scholarship recipient fails to comply with any of the conditions and obligations outlined above.

### 7. How to Apply:

Interested and eligible applicants are required to complete the online Scholarship Application Form via this link: <https://applicant.mfu.ac.th/registeren/login> and submit the following supporting documents:

- A recent 1-inch passport-style photograph.
- A certified copy of the degree certificate, along with a certified English translation if the original certificate was not issued in English.
- A certified copy of academic transcripts, along with a certified English

translation if the original transcripts were not issued in English.

- A copy of the applicant's passport,
- A Statement of Purpose describing the applicant's reasons for choosing the programme, as well as the concrete activity or initiative they propose to implement by positioning themselves as leaders or key facilitators in fostering 'global citizenship' among students and staff within the University
- A Concept Note or Research Proposal
- A recommendation letter from a former academic advisor and/or professor At the applicant's previous university
- An English proficiency test score report (TOEFL, IELTS, CU-TEP, MFU-TEP, TOEIC)
- A recommendation letter from the applicant's current employer (if applicable)
- A certified medical report from a licensed doctor.

Application must be submitted no later than **31 March 2026**.

#### **8. Announcement of Awardees**

The list of scholarship awardees will be announced in May 2026 on the MFU website ([www.mfu.ac.th](http://www.mfu.ac.th)). Successful applicants will receive an official notification via email.
