Re: Introduction of the Royal Thai Embassy's Bank Account for the Transfer of the Consular Fee from People Residing in the Republic of Azerbaijan, Georgia, the Republic of North Macedonia, and Turkmenistan

Pursuant to certain difficulties on the payment of consular services fee from people residing in the Republic of Azerbaijan, Georgia, the Republic of North Macedonia, and Turkmenistan to the Royal Thai Embassy in Ankara.

The Royal Thai Embassy hereby announces the introduction of the Embassy's bank account for international transfer of consular services fee, in particular visa application fee. All visa applicants and other clients residing in the Republic of Azerbaijan, Georgia, the Republic of North Macedonia, and Turkmenistan are able to transfer such fee to the following account:

The transfer of the services fee shall apply only to people residing in the Republic of Azerbaijan, Georgia, the Republic of North Macedonia, and Turkmenistan. The people residing

in the Republic of Türkiye are required to be present at the Royal Thai Embassy in Ankara for any consular services. It shall be noted that the bank transaction fee for the transfer be responsible by the applicants or clients themselves and the original copy of the consular services payment via bank transfer shall be included and submitted with all other required documents for each service to the Embassy.

As the fee for each service is stated in the website <u>ankara.thaiembassy.org</u>, any application for visa or other consular services, which the fee is not paid in the appropriate amount or the original copy of the payment is not attached thereto, would not be further proceeded and subject to rejection.
