On behalf of the Royal Thai Government, I wish to express my congratulations to the People's Republic of China, the Kingdom of Cambodia, the Lao People's Democratic Republic, the Republic of the Union of Myanmar and the Socialist Republic of Viet Nam on the occasion of the  $5^{\rm th}$  anniversary of the Mekong - Lancang Cooperation (MLC).

I firmly believe that, with our coordinated cooperation, the MLC will continue to grow stronger and contribute towards greater Mekong prosperity and sustainability in the years to come. Thailand therefore stands ready to work with all partners, parties and stakeholders for the mutual benefit of MLC member states, their peoples and beyond.
