เมื่อวันที่ 18 สิงหาคม 2556 สถานกงสุลใหญ่ ณ เมืองฮ่องกง ได้จัดกิจกรรมถวายพระพรวันเฉลิม พระชนมพรรษาสมเด็จพระนางเจ้าฯ พระบรมราชีนีนาถ เนื่องในโอกาสที่ทรงเจริญพระชนมายุครบ 81 พรรษา ณ โรงแรม Regal Oriental เขตเกาลูนซิตี้ โดยกงสุลใหญ่ฯ ได้นำทีมประเทศไทย และพสกนิกรชาวไทยในฮ่องกงกล่าว ถวายพระพร รวมทั้งร่วมร้องเพลงเฉลิมพระเกียรติสมเด็จพระนางเจ้าฯ และลงนามถวายพระพร ในโอกาสนี้ สถานกงสุล ใหญ่ฯ ได้จัดโครงการกงสุลสัญจร เพื่อให้บริการทำหนังสือเดินทางและด้านนิติกรณ์ต่าง ๆ และยังได้ร่วมมือกับกรม การกงสุล กระทรวงการต่างประเทศ จัดโครงการให้บริการตรวจสุขภาพกายและจิต โดยคณะแพทย์และพยาบาลจาก โรงพยาบาลสวนปรุง โรงพยาบาลเลิดสิน และสถาบันราชานุกูล กรมสุขภาพจิต กระทรวงสาธารณสุข โดยมีประชาชน ชาวไทยที่อาศัยอยู่ในฮ่องกงจำนวนกว่า 200 คน มารับบริการ ทั้งนี้ กิจกรรมทั้งสองดังกล่าวเป็นโอกาสอันดีให้ประชาชน ชาวไทยได้แสดงความจงรักภักดีต่อสมเด็จพระนางเจ้าฯ และช่วยกระชับความสัมพันธ์ระหว่างชุมชนไทยในฮ่องกงและ สถานกงสุลใหญ่ฯ ให้แน่นแฟ้นยิ่งขึ้น รวมทั้งเป็นการเสริมสร้างชุมชนไทยในฮ่องกงให้เข้มแข็งเป็นหนึ่งเดียว

On 18<sup>th</sup> August 2013, the Royal Thai Consulate-General in Hong Kong organised the Celebration of the 81<sup>st</sup> Birthday Anniversary of Her Majesty Queen Sirikit at the Regal Oriental Hotel, Kowloon City. On this auspicious occasion, the Consul-General led Team Thailand and the Thai community in Hong Kong in bidding their warmest congratulations to Her Majesty the Queen for Her Majesty's Birthday Anniversary. An approximate number of 200 Thais received various consular services, ranging from a passport issuance, legal assistance, as well as physical and mental check-ups by the medical team from Suanprung Hospital, Lerdsin Hospital and Rajanukul Institute, Department of Mental Health, Ministry of Public Health. Both activities provided the Thai people in Hong Kong with an opportunity to express their loyalty to Her Majesty the Queen as well as to strengthen the relations and unity of the Thai community in Hong Kong.



Her work in this field, moreover, expanded to free medical treatment programmes supported by volunteer doctors. Her Maiesty is also an honorary President of the Council of Social Welfare of Thuiland, from which numerous programmes have been carried out to empower people, especially That women and children, mentally and economically.

To further empower the people, the Queen, who possesses a gift for teaching, has expanded her support into the field of education, both formal and non-formal. in 1992; the AIT Gold Medal for Leadership in the Conservation of Natural Resources and Protection of the Environment by the Asian Institute of Technology, Bangkok, in 1992; the "Wo of the Year" by Stanford University, California, in 1993; the Honorary Doctoral Degree in Humane Letters by the Johns Hopkins University, in 1965; and the Gold Medal with Mention in recognition of outstanding achievements in the Training Programme to Improve Farmers' Income under the tutelage of The SUPPORT Foundation, awarded at the "Brussels EUREKA 2001: 50th Anniversary of the World Exhibition of Innovation, Research and New Technology", in 2001.
