

Tips for filling out student visa form Non-ED



1. To avoid unnecessary delay in the process. Make sure documents uploaded correspond with the form.

2. In some sections, more than one document may be required. Since you can only upload one single file to each section, it is highly recommended that you scan all relevant documents for each section into ONE file in PDF format. See bubbles below for details:

Supporting Documents

1. Biodata page of Passport or Travel Document +

No 3: Upload a pdf file containing:
(1) Declaration (2) financial statement
(3) For student less than 18 years old
please submit a guarantee letter from
applicant's parents.

No 4: Upload a pdf file containing:
(1) Letter confirming enrollment details from the educational institution in Thailand
(2) Letter of request for visa issuing from school or university in Thailand signed by university president or school director attached with a copy of identification card.
(3) Graduation certificate and a certificate of highest education notarized by notary office and approved by Office of Foreign affair, issued not more than 6 months

No 5: Upload a pdf file containing:
(1) University registration certificate
(2) flight itinerary (3) 6-month bank statement with minimum balance 50,000 RMB

No 7: Upload a pdf file containing ALL passport pages (for Chinese passport, all 47 pages must be uploaded)

No 8: Upload a pdf file of an ID card

Make sure all documents uploaded to section 1-9 are correct before clicking "Done" to submit the form

4. Letter confirming enrollment details from school signed by authorized person together with a copy of ID card or passport of the signer +

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5. Academic certificate from previous education level +

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6. University's registration certificate +

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7. Applicant is required to upload his/her passport pages which contain all travel records for the past 12 months (1 year) since the last international trip. +

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8. Applicant must apply for e-Visa via specific Embassy/Consulate conforming with his/her consular jurisdiction and residency. Applicant is required to upload document that can verify his/her current residency. +

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9. Please upload your picture holding the photo and information page of the passport. +
