



Announcement
Tourist Visa
(Effective from 9 October 2020)

The Royal Thai Consulate-General in Guangzhou wishes to inform Chinese and Foreign residents in China that the Royal Thai Consulate-General has resumed issuance of tourist visas to eligible applicants who meet the following requirements, effective from 9 October 2020. Details are as follows:

1. Eligibility of Applicants Chinese and foreign nationals, who currently reside in Guangdong and Hainan Provinces and intend to stay in Thailand for 60 days or less, can apply for a Tourist Visa (TR).

2. Validity of Visa A Single Entry only with validity of up to 60 days (valid for entering Thailand once within 3 months from the date of issuance.)

3. Required Documents for COE

3.1 A completed declaration form

3.2 A proof of payment for designated Alternative State Quarantine (ASQ) hotel of at least 14 days. For more information about ASQ, please visit <http://hsscovid.com>.

3.3 A proof of Health Insurance covering all medical expenses in Thailand with a minimum coverage of USD 100,000 that includes coverage for Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) treatment.

4. Required Documents for TR Visa Application

4.1 A passport valid for no less than 6 months

4.2 A fully completed and signed visa application form and its copy.

4.3 Two copies of passport (personal information page)

4.4 A proof of accommodation in Thailand after quarantine period in ASQ, e.g. accommodation reservation, invitation letters from family/friends in Thailand (Applicant must provide a copy of identity card (ID) of a family member.)

4.5 An original bank statement which states bank contact information and a deposit with the equivalent amount of not less than THB 500,000 for the past 6 months.

5. Other Requirements Upon arrival in Thailand, foreign nationals must strictly comply with disease control measures of Thai authorities, especially the 14-day quarantine, and are required to cover their related expenses.
